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RENOWNED German Bavarian band 'X'elch'ten' captivated guests with its traditional songs at the opening of this year's celebration of the world-famous Bavarian festival 'Oktoberfest' at the InterContinental Doha on Wednesday.

The four-day event, which will conclude on October 9, also featured an array of

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authentic Germany-made products and cuisines.

Oktoberfest is the world's largest fair which originated in Munich, Bavaria, Germany.

Besides the lavish celebration by Germans in their home country, the festival is being observed annually in many countries across the globe.

This is for the seventh consecutive year that InterContinental Doha is celebrating the festival.

It has been one of the most popular annual gatherings of German and other nationals resident in Qatar.

The huge tent set up at the hotel was adorned with long tables and chairs to create the setting similar to the festival observed in Munich and other countries.

The setting allowed for

more interaction among guests, which is one of the primary features of the celebration.

The Bavarian band 'X'elch'ten' delighted the guests with their German folk songs rendition and classic foot-tapping hits.

The guests, who could not resist the soulful songs, would every now and then be on their feet to dance along with the energetic musicians.

The mixed crowd also feast-

ed on traditional fare such as weisswurst (white sausage), hendl (chicken) and roast beef as well as other international cuisines, including an array of salads, pastries and desserts.
